**Do you want to volunteer in a brain
imaging study?**

We are looking for volunteers at least 18 years old to participate in this brain imaging research study. The purpose of this study is to see whether new metabolic imaging will be useful to physicians and patients with brain tumor for making treatment decisions.

The new metabolic imaging will use deuterated glucose, a form of non-radioactive sugar. Participants will be asked to drink water with deuterated glucose and then receive one MR examination, including both MR imaging data and proton (^1H) MR metabolic imaging. Blood sugar will be tested via fingertip before and after the MR examination. This study will take place at UCSF Mission Bay Campus.
